Conn Creek
Mendocino County

This creek is a tributary to Anderson Creek. It was noted to have a flow of 1/2 second ft. at a highway bridge crossing between Boonville and Philo. Warden Nerton reported steelhead utilized one mile of this creek for spawning. Above the mile point an impassable falls exists. The watershed of Conn Creek has suffered from extensive logging operations, resulting in erosion.
