Dear Mr. Carter:

This letter is in response to your inquiry of May 8, 1978 regarding your plans to construct a small reservoir on Parkinson's Gulch in the Navarro River Drainage.

We have completed our investigation and believe your project will not adversely affect fish or wildlife. Parkinson's Gulch does not have a fishery resource and it is doubtful if one would develop considering the steep stream grade and low summer flows.

In addition, the development of a pond would provide a valuable source of water for wildlife, particularly during late summer months. The planting of willow and blackberry near the pond would further enhance this wildlife value.
