This stream is a very short stream probably under 1 mile in length. It runs off the Mt. Tamalpais Range to the ocean at Stinson Beach. It is rather a steep running stream as its name implies. I've heard of salmon & steel head runs into it, though I have never noted any spawners there. I have sighted trout in the 2 to 6 inch class which I am sure do the spawning which keep the stream with some fish, as there are always several hundred fish taken there each year.

There are two access points, one in the Tam. Panoramic Highway at the white gate
